ORDINANCE NO: 2018-TO-045

ORDINANCE CONCERNING LITTER

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of public health, safety and welfare, has deemed it necessary that the Town develop an Ordinance that forbids littering within the Corporate limits of the Town of Greenville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Definitions

“Refuse” includes solid and semisolid wastes, dead animals, and offal.

Section 2. Littering a Class B Infraction

A person who recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally places or leaves refuse on property of another person, except in a container provided for refuse, commits littering, a Class B infraction.

Section 3. Littering a Class A Infraction

The offense becomes a Class A infraction if the refuse is placed or left in, on, or within one hundred (100) feet of a body of water that is under the jurisdiction of the;

1. Department of Natural Resources
2. United States Army Corps of Engineers

Section 4. Throwing burning material from a moving motor vehicle

A person commits a Class A Infraction for throwing from a moving motor vehicle;

1. A lighted cigarette, cigar, or match; or
2. Other burning material;

Section 5. Enforcement

Evidence that littering was committed from a moving vehicle other than a public conveyance constitutes prima facie evidence that it was committed by the operator of that vehicle.

Section 6. Penalty

Class A Infraction = \$1,000

Class B Infraction = \$200 - \$500
