



TOWN OF GREENVILLE ORDINANCE NO 2022-TO-018

ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN BUILDING ORDINANCES

Whereas the Town of Greenville entered into an interlocal agreement with Floyd County to act as the town of Greenville's Plan Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals; and

Whereas, in accordance with Indiana Law, the Floyd County Plan Commission conducted a public hearing on September 12, 2022 to consider the Towns Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Control Ordinance and Zoning Map; and

Whereas, the Floyd County Plan Commission certified the Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Control Ordinance and Zoning Map to the Town Council of the Town of Greenville, Indiana, with a favorable recommendation; and

Whereas, the town Council of the Town of Greenville, Indiana adopted the Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Control Ordinance and Zoning Map at its regular meeting on March 10, 2022; and


Whereas, the passage of the Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Control Ordinance and Zoning Map have rendered some of the Town's existing Ordinances obsolete or conflicting with the newly adopted ordinances.


NOW LET IT BE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:
