

Constitution of the Greenville Township Volunteer Fire Department

1. This association shall be known as the name of the Greenville Township Volunteer Fire Dept.
2. Said association being organized under the Civilian Defense and subject thereto.
3. The object of this association shall be for the purpose of preventing loss by fire to property in Greenville Township, Floyd County Indiana caused by enemy action, accidental or otherwise.
4. All citizens of Greenville Township shall be eligible for membership.
5. The officers shall be Township Trustee, a Treasurer and an advisory committee of five members who shall constitute the Executive Board and have power to act for the association.
6. The advisory committee shall elect from their membership a chairman and a secretary.

4. Ten members of the association shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any regular meeting or special meeting of the association.

Three members of the Executive Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting.
