

The upper floors of the buildings were used by fraternal organizations. The Oddfellows* used the west building & their emblem on the front is dated 1894, evidently when they began meeting there. Several signs & relics are displayed inside the present antique shop. This building is the more sophisticated architecturally than the other.

The east building was used by the Masons*. Their emblem on the front of the building is dated 1879.

Around the turn of the century & later the upstairs hall of the west building was used for church suppers, socials, dances, plays, & later movies.
