
Seibert Dodge complained of sewage and litter on the property near him. The County Health Inspector has investigated and will have to pursue the matter further.

Terry Boaz stated a spot light and a leak detector are needed for maintenance of our water lines. The board agreed that they should be purchased.


Robert Gibson moved the meeting be closed.
