The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board, held this date, was called to order by President Jack Sprigler. Present were all board members, M. Mason, B. Isgrigg, J. Gibson, G. Getrost, T. Richardson, M. Powell, D. Jackson, P. Buche, Greg Wright, and Chris McGehee.

Jack Sprigler announced that H.L. Spears has been chosen by the Board as the new President of the Board. Spears accepted the gavel.

Chris McGehee, representing developers of property on Featheringill Road, said he came to work out an agreement with the Board to extend the water line on Featheringill Road. McGehee proposed the developers guarantee a specified number of tap-in fees, or front \$3,000 to \$4,000 to the water utility for the line extension. Max Mason advised the Board and McGehee that a written proposal should address when tap-in fees would be paid, when to begin paying a minimum bill, and when the water line would be laid. Gary Getrost reminded the Board that property owners paid for the line extension on the upper end of Featheringill Road (Buttontown Road to the curve).

The Board decided to change suppliers of bottle gas at the Town Hall from Hartfield to Pearce.


The Board decided some changes in personnel policy for full time Water Utility employees. 1) Paychecks will be issued weekly. 2) Each employee has five sick leave days a year. When sick leave has been depleted an employee will use vacation leave or leave-without-pay. 3) Vacations must be taken within the calendar year. 4) Comp time will be taken only for work done on holidays.

Gary Getrost announced that V.J. Miller received State certification for treatment plant operator and distribution system operator.

Getrost informed the Board that the tailgate was stolen off the gray truck.

There being no further business coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
