and the extended line will built to  
our water company specifications  
and be inspected by our water  
company inspector.

The town dump was discussed.  
It is no longer used, and the board  
feels the land should be sold.  
The trash in the dump needs to  
be covered. Action was tabled until  
a later meeting.

Kelbert Gibson stated that the  
back road should be opened to  
Greenville Park to facilitate getting  
into the park. They need to  
find out whether the C. C. S. money  
could be used for this purpose.
