Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All members, Charles Birkla, and two visitors were present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer's report shows a total checking account balance of \$5,799.49 (General Fund- \$568.32; Street Fund \$3,150.32; and CCIF \$2,080.85. Our Revenue Sharing Fund is \$3,625.00).

The board agreed to invest \$3,500 of our Revenue Sharing monies in 3 month Certificates of Deposit until such time that the funds would be needed.

Robert Gibson reported that the garbage has been cleaned up at the sale barn and that the houses around the barn are preparing to correct their sewage problems.

Robert Gibson reported that our preliminary sewer report has been signed and sent to the state for consideration.

A meeting with an official from local State Highway District will be held shortly so that we can obtain forms and information for applying for R & S funds.

Robert Gibson moved and Donald Uhl seconded that the water company discontinue water service to anyone failing to comply with the county health officier's recommendation for improving sanitary conditions in and around the water meter and water lines. All voted in favor of the motion.

Donald Uhl stated rock should be placed in a few areas. The board agreed that Harrison Street should be opened all the way to the park.

Donald Uhl moved the Meeting be closed.
