

# Gruverville Sewer Board Meeting

March 13, 1942

Jerry Boaz opened the meeting. All members were present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Claims were presented and approved for payment.

Furness Burkhat suggested we invest \$700.00 in a (3) three month Certificate of Deposit. The money will not be needed until June, 1942 unless it will be used to retire bonds. This action was approved.

Our water company in the near future will need to go under U.S. 150. Jerry Boaz will get the proper permits.

Two hundred (200) homes are ~~located~~ <sup>situated</sup> near Boyd Central School. Our engineers think a water tower in the area will be needed to accommodate

Gary Jacob is to find a deed for the town dump so that a resolution can be made to sell the dump.

It was the feeling of the board that there are too many dogs running loose in the town. New Albany has a good dog ordinance and it was studied to see if we could use portions of their ordinance. Gary Jacob is to talk to John Cady, town lawyer.

Thos McLain and Stanley Burkert presented a garbage bill for December, 1971, that the town was committed to pay.

A resource person, Oscar Hopkins, will be invited to meet and counsel on the proposed sewers with the town board.
