April 11, 1977 Greenville School Basement

Meeting called to order by President Robert Gibson. Minutes of March 14 and 21, 1977 meetings were read and approved as read.

All board members were present.

The Treasurers' report was presented to the board.

Mr. Geswein questioned the board on water installation at his property. He stated the property he owns and other property owners are willing to give the Water Utility easements for construction of water lines. A request was made by Mr. Geswein to approach those owners to obtain easements. The Water Utility agreed to obtain such easements.

Mr. & Mrs. Boling, of Greenville Town, comparined about a dumping problem and water overflow at the rear of their property. The Town Board agreed to check out the problem of dumping and water overflow. Mr. Gibson stated since the area in question is a public street maybe the town could open the street to the public and resurface with stone and eventually asphalt. The town board agreed to pursue the matter of repair and resurface.

James Harl advised the board he would take notes on sewer construction plans.

Ed. Barnett, of Midwest Engineering, presented to those present at this meeting, an update on sewer funds. Mr. Barnett advised the board he would check with E.P.A. on disbursing of funds. James Harl, representing Township Advisory Board, questioned Mr. Barnett on area of sewer construction. Mr. Gibson intervened that the Town of Greenville had approval from Floyd County for sewer construction. James Hartfield questioned Mr. Barnett what would be the status of sewer construction if Floyd County decided that Greenville Township is to be included in the county wide sewer plan. Mr. Barnett stated his firm could be ready for public hearings on sewers in about six(6) months. Mr. Barnett stated the grant agreement has been approved. Fund disbursements will be made after necessary paperwork is completed. He also provided Mr. Harl with an update on sewers, rates, areas, etc.

Mr. Scott Stewart, of the Manpower Development Board presented the board with a contract between the City of New Albany and the Town of Greenville to run through September 30, 1977 for the position of Maintenance Man for Greenville Town and Greenville Water Utility, under the CETA program.

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Building Permits from Greenville Lodge #416, F. & A. M. and Mr. Sibert Dodge was presented to the board and approved, this being the first of such permits issued since its inception.

James Hartfield, in the capacity as insurance representative, informed the board on insurance matters. He recommended term insurance for the town maintenance man. Mr. Gibson made a motion to purchase \$25,000 term life insurance at a semi-annual premimum of \$34.27 for this position under C.E.T.A. This was seconded by Pearl Tush. Mr. Hartfield advised the board of disability insurance for the town marshalls and deputies. Mr. Gibson questioned the marshall and deputy if they would be willing to contribute toward such a policy due to high costs involved. Town Marshall James Harl and Deputy Robert Tilly declined insurance offer for disability as presented by Mr. Hartfield due to the high cost. Both stated they would purchase their own policies for such disability.

Armintie Prather was appointed a Deputy Marshall on motion by Robert Gibson, seconded by William Voyles.

Mr. Gibson moved that the meeting be adjourned.
