Meeting called to order by President Robert Gibson. Minutes of April 11 meeting was read and approved. The Treasurers' report was presented to the board. All Board members were present. In addition, those in attendance were Ernie Purvis, James Harl, Robert Tilly, Dan Cristiani, Chet Tush and Gary Getrost.

Pearl Tush questioned if a "no dumping" sign could be erected by the Methodist Church. Mr. Chet Tush agreed to contact the State of Indiana for such sign if requested. Robert Gibson requested the Town of Greenville order four (4) 09D-432 "No Dumping" signs. This was seconded by Pearl Tush.

Mr. Gibson advised the board of an ordinance that is required for regulating garage and yard sales. Mr. Max Mason, Jr. advised the board via telephone and via letter of the status of such proposed ordinance.

An Ordinance Regulating Garage and Yard Sales Within the Town of Greenville was read. On Motion by William Voyles, seconded by Robert Gibson the Town Board adopted such ordinance regulating such sales. Attached to these minutes is a copy of the Ordinance pursuant to provisions of I.C. 1971, 18-3-1-48.

Water line installation problems were discussed by Mr. Gibson and Mr. Cristiani. Both informed the board of easements needed to extend the water line from Ramsey Water Company. It was stated the installation of lines in Floyd County has come to a standstill due to problems of obtaining easements. Various water line installations were discussed with no affirmative action taken by the board.

Mr. Purvis informed the board of the amount of water the utility has at its disposal. He also informed the board that in the event the utility has bad water samples necessary letters to all customers must be sent out. He stated that Greenville Water Utility has not had any bad water samples, and he does not foresee such condition at the present time.

James Harl informed the board of a dog problem in the town. He asked the board to have our attorney to check into the matter. Pearl Tush agreed to contact the attorney concerning this matter. Mr. Harl also requested ~~to~~ red light for the town police car. Estimated cost to be about \$140.00. William Voyles made motion to authorize the purchase of one (1) set of lights and bar. This was seconded by Pearl Tush.

Pearl Tush made motion that the Town of Greenville and Greenville Water Utility jointly purchase a lawn mower for use at the lake site and town areas. This was seconded by William Voyles.

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Pearl Tush made motion to adjourne the meeting.

TOWN BOARD OF GREENVILLE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF GARAGE AND YARD SALES

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Greenville may, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 1971, 18-3-1-48, make and establish such by-laws, ordinances, and regulations, not repugnant to the laws of the State of Indiana, as may be reasonably necessary for the conduct of town affairs and for the protection of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the Town and of the public; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 1971, 18-3-1-41, the Town Board of Greenville may license, regulate or restrain certain commercial activities, to include the sale of wares and merchandise within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Greenville has deemed it necessary and appropriate to enact an ordinance having as its purpose the regulation of yard or garage sales conducted by residents and others within the limits of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, no person, firm or corporation shall conduct or cause to be conducted within the corporate limits of the Town of Greenville, a garage or yard sale without first having made application to, and received from, the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Greenville a permit authorizing said sale. The permit issued by the Clerk-Treasurer shall disclose the name of the person, firm, or corporation to whom issued; the date of issuance; and location where the sale is to be conducted; the duration of the sale, which shall not in any event exceed 48 hours; and, said permit shall clearly state thereon the following prohibition:

No sign or other advertising material to be used in conjunction with the sale for which this permit is issued shall be erected or situated upon any street, road, or highway right-of-way within the Town, or at or upon any publicly owned or operated real estate, building, or establishment.

For purposes of this ordinance, the term "garage or yard sale" shall be deemed to include the sale or barter, not in the course of an established trade or business, of household goods, house wares, clothing or other personal property, conducted at or upon real estate within the Town of Greenville used predominantly or primarily for residential purposes, and for which a special exception or variance has not been issued by the Floyd County Plan Commission and/or Floyd County Board of Zoning Appeals permitting the commercial sale of such property or merchandise thereon.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Greenville, upon issuance of a permit pursuant to this ordinance, shall collect from the applicant a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that within a period of thirty (30) days, not more than one permit shall be issued to any single applicant, and not more than one permit shall be issued for the conduct of a garage or yard sale at any single location within the Town of Greenville.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a permit issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be plainly and openly displayed by the applicant at the location stated thereon and at all times during the conduct of the sale authorized thereby.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance or any of the terms or provisions of a permit issued pursuant hereto, shall be subject to a fine or penalty of \$25.00 pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 1971, 18-3-1-49 and shall be subject to prosecution pursuant to the provision of I.C. 1971, 18-3-1-53 or other applicable statutes of the State of Indiana.
