Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All member, Charles Birkla and one visitor were present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer's report shows a check-fund total of \$7,140.11 (General Fund \$2,470.68, Local Roads \$ 697.50, Street \$2,123.10 and CCIF \$1,848.83). The Revenue Sharing checking has a total of \$3,535.71. Farnsley Burkhart's March water reports agree with the bank statement.

Terry Boaz reported that the wards boundaries are set. This will more equally divide the population. The 1st ward boundaries are E. ~~1st~~^{2nd St} and all west. The 2nd ward boundaries are E. ~~1st~~^{2nd St} and to Buttontown Road. The 3rd ward boundaries are Buttontown Road and all east of there.

Robert Ross reported that he and Charles Keithley want to open a body shop at the old auction barn. The board stated that the grounds should be kept clean.


The board will ask Stanley Zollman to be Deputy Marshall. The board agreed to pay his bond.


Robert Gibson reported that lots should be mowed and the fire hydrants be painted. Charles Birkla is to do the work.
