## **Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013**

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, and Greg Redden, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Town Manager Randal Johnes, Marshal Bill Burkhart, Water Superintendent Gary Getrost and several concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer from Pastor Avery, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Marshal Report:**

Marshal Burkhart presented the council members with the monthly report. All five (5) members of the department completed training held at the Indiana Marshal's conference. This is the majority of training needed to stay current. All members have the same training and should be more compatible during regular investigations and performing daily duties.

Lieutenant Moore was re-elected as President of the Indiana Marshall's Association. Moore has arranged for the department to receive an M-14 assault rifle at no charge from the Fort Wayne Police Department, this is part of the government surplus equipment package. The department must turn the weapon back over to the program if they decide the need is gone. Moore has been working on a grant for funding to help retain police officers.

### **Financial:**

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town. The checks were approved without objections.

**Minutes:** The minutes for April 08th regular meeting was discussed. Motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the proposed amended minutes. Motion passed 4-0.

### **Committee Reports:**

#### **Property Cleanups:**

There has been some complaints about properties in Greenville. President Richardson has decided there will be a new procedure for receiving complaints. The only way that a complaint can be filed is in written form. The complaint form will be available at the Utility Company front desk and on line at the Greenville website. The form must be complete and contain a signature to be investigated.

#### **Streets and Roads:**

The bids for paving Clark Street were opened and were as follows:

Striegel Paving	\$ 44,163
Hollis Paving	\$ 46,490
Libs Paving	\$ 28,670

The council voted 4-0 to accept the lowest bid and suggested that Councilman Wright confirm the contract specification before beginning the project.

**Town Manager:** Randal Johnes has posted his report on the town website along with emailing all council members and the clerk. No questions concerning the report.

**Ordinance 2013-MR-028:** RESOLUTION CONCERNING MARSHAL DEPARTMENT CELL PHONE SERVICE CONTRACT WITH VERIZON WIRELESS FOR THE GREENVILLE MARSHAL DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

**Ordinance 2013-TR-026:** RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BOARD OF DIRECTORS, DEPARTMENT OF WATERWORKS, UTILITY SERVICE BOARD FOR THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Reading of the resolution was completed. There was a discussion about the timing of this resolution. It was suggested that this could wait until the vote is completed in November on reducing the number of council seats. The resolution was tabled for later consideration.

**Water Utility Business:**

**Ordinance 2013-WR-027:** RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SELECTION OF AN INSURANCE CARRIER REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY FROM JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2013 THROUGH MAY 31<sup>ST</sup>, 2014: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

Superintendent Getrost gave the monthly adjustment report. The council accepted the adjustments without comment. Superintendent Getrost gave an update about the ongoing projects. The tank is being filled, it is taking longer than expected. Before changing over there will need to be testing of the water. Following the change over Phoenix Fabricators will dismantle the existing tanks. The pumping station will be tested at the end of the month.

**Change order:** There has been a change order submitted concerning the water tower project. The motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0.

**Sewer Plant:**

Deputy Superintendent Schmidt gave a report about the newly acquired sewage treatment plant. He has spent about 10 hours at the plant with the managing contractor. Steven submitted a list of needed improvements. The council stated these were normal day to day expenses and should be dealt with from approval of Superintendent Getrost.

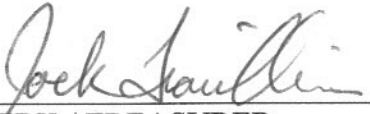
The council received a complaint about the conduct of an employee. There was a hearing and the complaint was found to be unsupported.

Pastor Jason Sparks from Redeeming Vine Baptist Church was in attendance and stated that the congregation has moved services from Palmyra to the 9200 block of Highway 150 in Greenville. The church will be holding a free medical clinic on July 27, 2013 from 10am to 2pm. The council welcomed the church to the community.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.

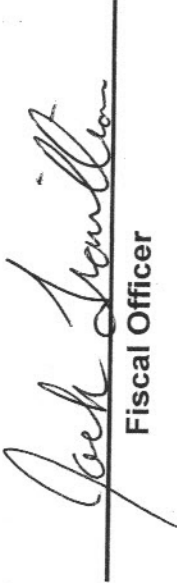

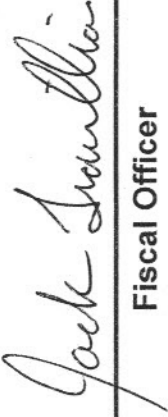

### **Federal Universal Service Charge**

Wireless carriers are assessed by the federal government to fund the delivery of universally-affordable telecommunications and information services under the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) program.

The Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) is a percentage of the customer's applicable monthly wireless service charges based upon an assessment rate that changes quarterly. The rate for the quarter beginning – April 1, 2013 is 3.63% of the following items:

- Cellular Access for voice calling plans (only on first 79% of this item)
- Verizon Wireless Toll
- Roaming Charges
- Activation Charges
- Re-connect fees
- Landline Connect Fee
- TXT Messaging monthly service
- TXT Messaging usage
- Airtime usage for voice calls
- Mobile to Mobile feature
- Nights and Weekends feature
- Toll free feature

The FUSC on other separately billed interstate and international long distance charges is 15.5%.

The quarterly percentage rate described above for the FUSC is applied in our billing system.

Verizon Wireless also imposes state universal service charges. These charges vary by jurisdiction and are subject to change depending on changes in the state universal service impositions on Verizon Wireless.

### **Regulatory Charge**

The FCC assesses wireless carriers the costs of enforcement, policy and rulemaking. The Regulatory Fee recovers Verizon Wireless' share of these costs, as well as some of the costs of implementing regulatory mandates, such as number portability. The Regulatory Charge is a flat charge of \$0.16 per Mobile Telephone Number (MTN) per month (excluding BroadbandAccess and NationalAccess Plans) and is \$0.02 per mobile number per month for BroadbandAccess and NationalAccess Plans, but is subject to change over time.

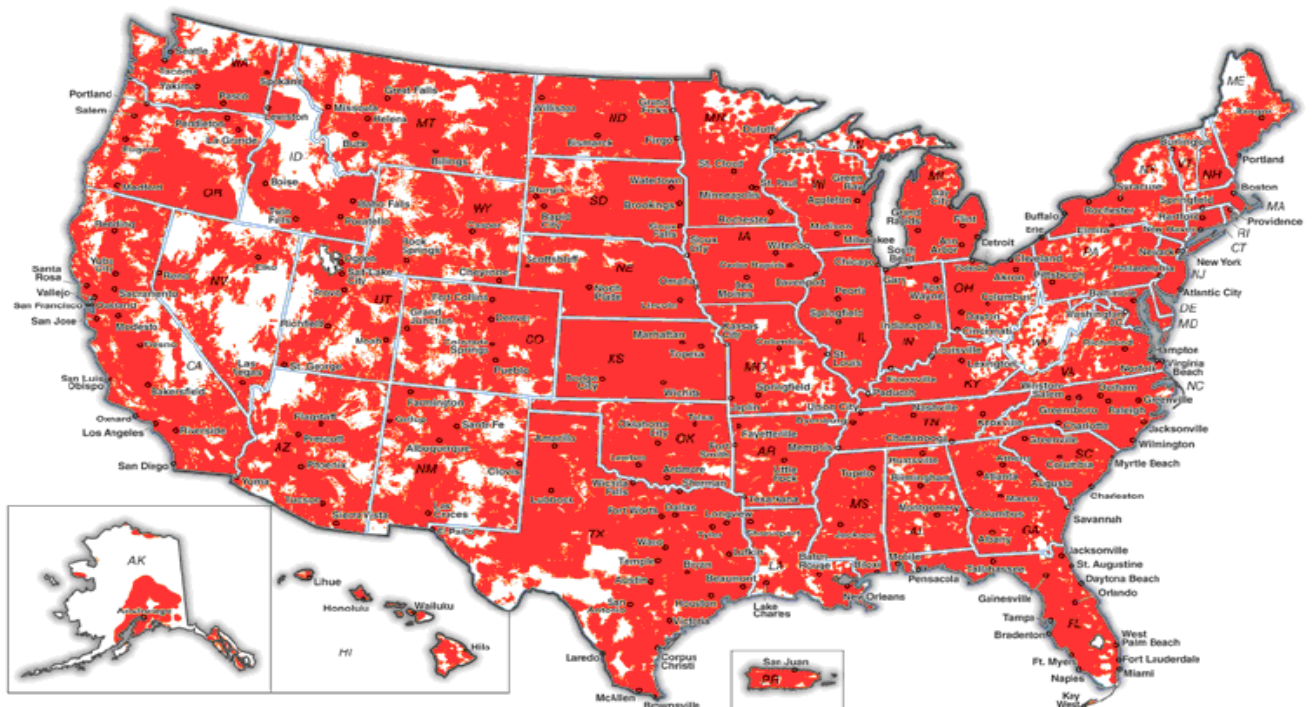

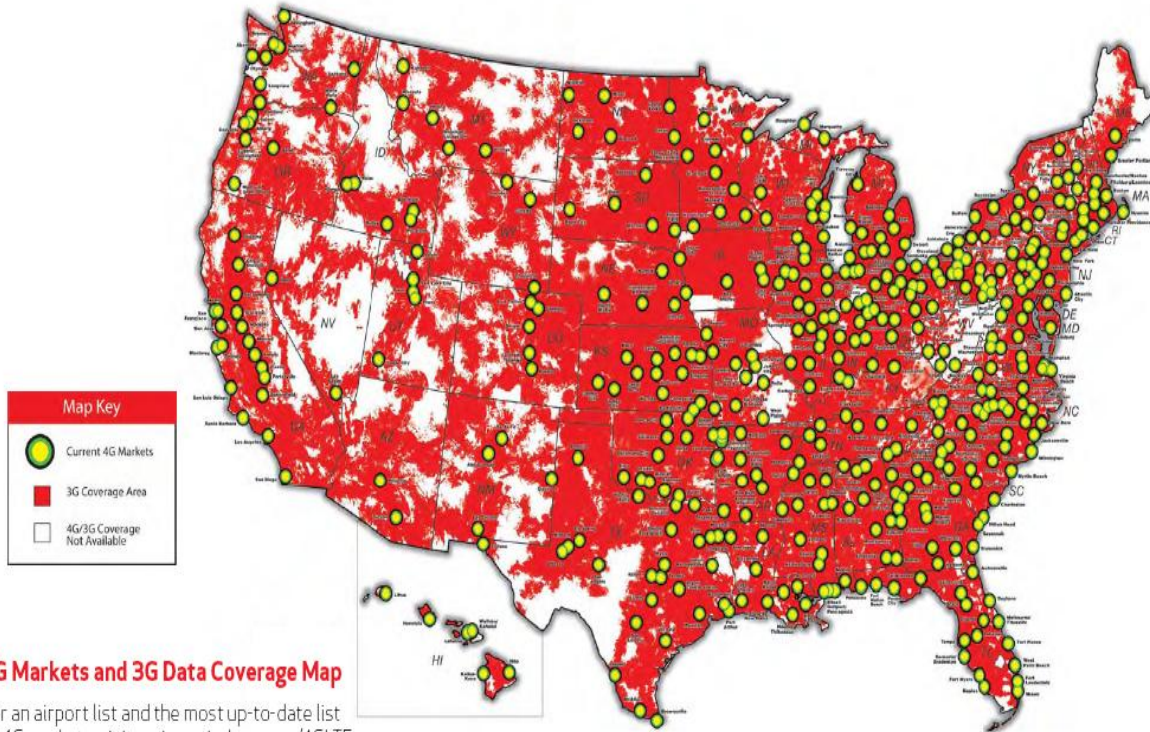

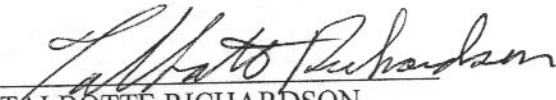

In my hast to get this to you, I am forwarding to you the communication that I received from my associate Lynn Cavan, who as you know has worked with you and Amy on this issue.

I would like to call to your attention what we were able to negotiate with Humana, and which we believe is to the benefit of the Town of Greenville. Thus:

- 6% relief in the renewal rate for the Health Insurance.
- 5% relief in the renewal rate for the Life, Accidental Death & Dismemberment Insurance,
- 2% relief in the renewal rate for the Dental Insurance.
- No increase / Rate Hold for the Short Term Disability Insurance.
- No increase / Rate Hold for the Long Term Disability Insurance.

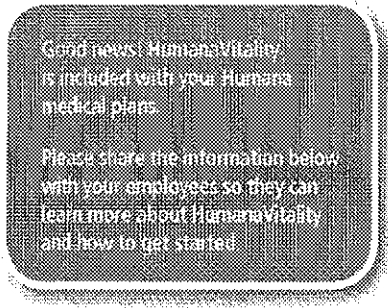

## Important Information Regarding Mental Health and Substance Abuse Benefits

The Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008, HR 1424, included provisions that amended the existing federal mental health parity requirements. The new legislation requires the same treatment and financial limits that apply to medical benefits also apply to mental health and substance abuse benefits.

Only employers with 51 or more employees are subject to this new legislation. Group size is based on the total number of employees, not the number covered under the employer's health plan. The total number of employees is calculated as follows:

Full time employees + part time employees + COBRA/state continuation participants  
= the total number of employees.

Based on the above calculation, the following scenarios exist, which may require action on your part:

- If your group has 50 or fewer employees, your mental health and substance abuse benefits will not change; therefore, no action is required on your part.
- If your group has 51 or more employees and the total number of enrolled employees in your medical plan is 51 or more, your plan has been modified to include these new mental health and substance abuse benefits. No action is required on your part.
- **If your group has 51 or more employees and the total number of enrolled employees in your medical plan is 50 or less, please contact your agent or broker immediately. Your agent/broker will update your mental health and substance abuse benefits prior to your renewal to ensure compliance with this legislation.**

If your group has experienced significant workforce changes (above or below 50 employees), please notify us of these changes. It is your responsibility to inform us of this change, so please contact your agent for assistance.
