## MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ron Lamb, with all Councilmembers and the Clerk of the Council present.

Also in attendance was Bud Ollis, David Owens, Dennis Thomas, Sheri Jecker, Scott Ham, Talbott Richardson, and Gary Getrost.

The Council approved the minutes of the May meeting and claims for the town and utility. The Clerk Treasurers' report indicate bank balances appear to be correct.

The Council gave 1st, 2d, and 3rd reading to Ordinance 1991-01, Ammending Ordinance 1990 (Salary Ordinance). Council approved Ordinance 1991-01 with members voting: R. L. Lamb - Yes; H.M. Hall - Yes; R. J. Williams - Yes.

Bud Ollis complained of car parked between his property and the house located to his west on Harrison Street, and trash build-up at rear of this property. Council advised him the town would contact the Floyd County Health Board regarding such trash and that there is no Ordinance prohibiting parking of cars along the street providing it is not blocking traffic.

Ron Lamb stated Stuart Boaz contacted him to have the alley running between the Boaz property on U.S. 150 and Clark Street from Pekin Road to E. 5th Street closed. Since the Council did not receive a written request no action was taken, but Councilmembers stated they were not in favor of such closing.

Ron advised Talbott Richardson that the Rental Agreement for property located on Clark Street will be terminated August 31, 1991. Effective September 1, 1991 the Marshall and Deputy Marshall will be paid a monthly salary as follows:

Marshall - \$200/Monthly

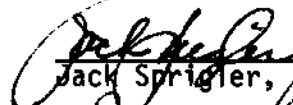
Deputy Marshall - \$100/Monthly

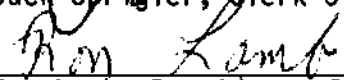
with appropriate taxes withheld.
