Talbotte reported his department had worked traffic for 82 hours, stopped 154 vehicles, and issued 5 tickets.



H. L. Spears said Butch Krieger had contacted him about putting in a turn around at the end of the street where Krieger lives. The Board said the Town doesn't have the funds.


Elaine Miller asked if the Board had any changes for the budget. They said to keep it about the same.
