The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board was held this date, opened by President Jack Sprigler. Present were V.J. Miller, H.E. Spears, John Geswein, David Snyder, Gary Zollman, David Eberenz, Gary Getrost, Gary Libs, Janice Gibson and other interested persons.

Minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved. Financial statements were presented to each board member.

Mr. Geswein requested water for his residence on Stiller Road. Gary Getrost will study the problems and report to the board next month.

The Board approved the request by Public Service Indiana to commit all street lights to High Pressure Sodium Vapor Lamps at no cost to the town of Greenville and also approved the installation of one (1) streetlight in Parkland Heights, motion made by MR. Spears seconded by Mr. Miller.

The Town Board authorized purchase of a used automobile in the amount of \$1200.00. Motion by Mr. Miller seconded by Mr. Spears.

The Board approved payments to the following Companies, Environmental Consultants \$4,600.00 and \$1300.00

David Snyder Backhoe Co. \$101,504.75

Don Cristiani Excavating Co. \$6334.40.

Motion by Mr. Miller seconded by H. Spears.


The Town received payment from F.H.A. in the amount of \$ 135,000.00.
