The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board was opened by Acting President H.L. Spears. The meeting held in the Town Hall was attended by R. Lamb, G. Getrost, Marvin Powell, T. Richardson, M. Mason B. Isgrigg and other interested persons.

The minutes of the last meeting and the financial statements were presented to the Board for approval. Mr. Lamb motioned to waive the reading of the minutes.

Mr. Spears made a motion to raise the price from \$85 to \$1.45 per thousand Gallons when there is a water leak. The motion was outlined as follows---

Step I. The leak is defined as a loss of water which exceeds by 50% the individuals average water usage for the preceding three months.

Step II. For each thousand gallons included within the loss of water the individual would be charged \$1.45 per thousand gallons.

Step III. Any adjustment in an individuals bill which exceeds \$50.00 shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees. Other adjustments shall be approved by the Plant Superintendent and Water Utility Office Manager. This motion was seconded by Mr. Lamb.

A letter from Mr. Leslie who bought the Wallace Miller property asks for permission to build a retaining wall to take care of a water run-off problem. Ron Lamb made the motion to give the permission requested, without help from the Town and as long as it does not affect the Town Streets. This motion was seconded by Buck Spears.

Buck Spears made a motion that was seconded by Ron Lamb to buy the new Badges numbered for our Town Marshall and his Deputy.

Mr. Getrost reports - The Spillway on the Levee is fixed; the Hydraulic pump on the Backhoe is going out. Need to think about building a Garage.
Dan Cristiani to fix the Spillway also to take the Back hoe to have it fixed.

Max Mason--Concerning the old houses, need specifics to tell owners what we want done.

No other business before the board Ron Lamb motioned for adjournment.

Gentlemen:

We herein request that the Board apply to the EPA through the Indiana Stream Pollution Control Board for a budget period extension to complete the Facility Plan. We recommend that the extension be from the existing expiration date of October 1, 1982, to December 31, 1982.

The extension is based upon the following timetable:

The main reason for requesting a time extension is a misunderstanding between the ISBH and Midwestern. As you know, we requested modification to the NPDES permit on May 27, 1982. A response was received June 25, 1982 from the ISBH which requested additional information. Additional information, a completed application, was furnished to the ISBH on July 15, 1982. After several telephone conversations and a trip to the ISBH, we received a letter on August 30, 1982, which indicated a modification of the permit was not required to investigate the facultative pond treatment process. Since receipt of the letter,

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we have started work on the amendment but lost approximately two months
while awaiting the ISBH reply.
