The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Baard was held this date, opened by acting President William Voyles. Present was Pearl Tush, Bob Isgrigg, Grace Martin, Gary Getrost, Virginia Ham, James Hazelwood, Gary Libs, V.J. Miller, representatives of Umbaugh Associates, and other interested persons.

Minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved. Financial statements was presented to each board member.

Ms. Ham questioned the board on the lake closing. Motion was made by Pearl Tush, seconded by Bill Voyles to close the lake around the same time as last years closing.

Representatives of Umbaugh Associates informed those present of current financial condition of the utility. They advised improvments were to be financed through the sale of revenue bonds and the approximate rate of increase in water rates.

Pearl Tush motioned approval of awards for water plant improvments to Snyder Backhoe Service and Mather Construction, seconded by Bill Voyles.

James Hazelwood advised the board of the repairs needed to the town truck. The board authorized Mr. Hazelwood to proceed with estimates as to the cost and the board would advise him if money is available.

Janice Gibson notified the board of the resignation of Rosalee Dowell and requested the board approve the=hiring of a replacement. Bill Voyles made motion to hire another person, seconded by Pearl Tush, at a rate of \$3.00 per hour.

The newly elected Town Board to take office January 1, 1980 advised that Jack Sprigler was elected President and salaries for the year 1980 would be approximately 34,020. Increases amounting to approximately $\frac{13.00}{1000}$ was approved.

The board felected) also approved an expenditure of approximately \$______ for a computer system for the water utility.

No further business coming before the board, Pearl Tush motioned for adjornment, seconded by William royles.
