The attached Water Purchase Contract between Floyds Knobs as purchaser and Ramsey Water as seller is returned. The contract has been approved.

Br. Rudy mentions in his transmitted that an about each of the Ramsey-Greenville contract is help, paragon. He has y states a problem with the elimination of a minimum parended by Arcenville. Fr. Harrin of Ramsey finds the climination of this provision objectionable. Hr. Rudy further states than Greenville would probably purchase three million gallons of water per months.

we suggest a minimum charge results in the Greenville contract and the contract be immediately assigned to FleyCondachs. Greenville will use more than one million pullogs per month, so the minimum purchase is academic. However, Floyds Knobe recks accountable of a minimum purchase, so assume the random perchase required fire of Floyds Knobe accommodates the one million gallon minimum purchase by decenville.

Please furnish the computation of the 0.05 (5%) add on for water from Floyds Knobs to Greenville.
