Terry Boaz opened the meeting. Terry Boaz, Robert Gibson, Gary Jacobi, William Voyles, Pearl Tush, Rita Tucker, Janice Gibson, Ernest Furvis, James Harl, Robert Tilley, and 3 guests were present. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer's report as of November 30, 1975 shows a checking fund balance of \$7,305.67. (General \$2,408.91, Localroads \$657.90, Street \$3,714.85 and CCIF \$3,524.01) The Revenue Sharing Checking fund has a balance of \$2,922.15. The Street fund has a 3 month certificate of deposit of \$6,000.00 and the CCIF has a certificate of deposit for \$11,000.00.

Janice Gibson water receipts for October and November appear to agree with the bank statements.

The board agreed to buy a used radio for the deputy marshall's car. The radio will have a year's warranty and will cost under \$400.00.

James Harl reported that the Greenville township has some office equipment consisting of a desk, filing cabinet and a stove that it will loan to the office of marshall of Greenville. The board agreed to accept the loan of office equipment.

Ernest Furvis reported that the State Board of Health would now permit us to resume sale of bulk water. A key will be provided to bulk haulers who pay a deposit of \$25.00 and whose accounts for water are currently paid up.

Bob Elliott of Midwest Engineers presented plans for expansion of our water supply. The board agreed to pursue plan C of his report and authorized Midwest Engineers to act on our behalf. Plan C entails buying water from the Ramsey Water Company bringing an 8 inch line into the Floyd Central area, selling water To Floyds Knobs Water Company. The board also recommended that on the recommendation of the engineers that we include in our proposal a bulk storage in the Floyd Central area. Bob Elliot pointed out that the water rates may change as a result of paying off the expansion of the water source.

Robert Gibson moved the meeting be closed.
