ORDINANCE NO. 2020-TO-004**

**ORDINANCE CONCERNING ESTABLISHING A COLLECTION FEE FOR
COMMERCIAL VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (VIN) CHECKS BY
THE GREENVILLE TOWN MARSHAL'S DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Greenville's Marshal's Department is often contacted to perform Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) checks by local companies.

WHEREAS, The Town Council of Greenville, Indiana desirous of collecting a fee for this service when performed for commercial purposes. IC 9-17-2-12 allows the Town Marshal and/or deputy officers to collect a fee not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) per VIN check.

WHEREAS, the monies collect from these inspections must be deposited in to an inspection fund only for law enforcement purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Greenville's Marshal's Department is now authorized to collect five US dollars (\$5.00) for each VIN check performed for commercial purposes.
2. No fee will be collect from private citizens.
3. The fees collected will be added to an inspection fund and will be used by the Marshal's Department
